About this team:

Imagine Packing is the HUB of the farm. It is where the freshly harvested veggies come, get washed, sorted, packed and sent to delivery for our eager waiting customers. The Packing team is a truly cross functional working group that pivots between harvesters to sales and marketing and finally to delivery. They are strong communicators, high performers, fast paced individuals who value hard work and fun everyday.

A day in the life:

The Packing Co-leader is responsible for helping the Packhouse Leader with the processing, packing, and shipping of Les jardins Carya harvest and resale items.

- Reception, quality control, cleaning, sorting, packaging and loading for delivery of Carya production and produce brought in from other farms
- Data entry into farm software
- Managing stored and unsold inventory
- Maintaining a clean and organised packing area
- Maintenance of packing area equipment
- Managing employees and volunteers in the packhouse
- Clear and concise communication with sales and harvest leaders
- Clear and concise communication with farm managers
- Occasional sales help at Wednesday farm stand
- Regular farm hand work, 2-3 days per week
